COMMUNITY MATTERS

As a group, along with Pepper Black, Director of Resident Programming, we discussed the following:

1. **Abandoned Bikes.**

- Office maintenance tagged and removed old bikes. We were very pleased at the speed and thoroughness with which this was done.

2. **Family Friday.**

- Family Friday has been very successful. We discussed funding for pizza and successful past activities that Family Friday has hosted. Favorites included Bingo and the Holiday party. We discussed possibilities and suggestions for future activities.

3. **Housing Codes.**

- There has been a rewording of the housing codes. The new codes will be mailed to everyone in the Village. Impacted areas include a new definition of excessive noise and a mandate that smoking not take place within 20 feet of any building.

4. **Random Items.**

- Subletting is legal during the summer as long as the proper paperwork is done through the Village Office.
- Parents of students are allowed to live in the Village with the student as long as they are on the lease.

- Section A is slated for demolition but nothing is now planned to take its place. The Gill Tract Research Center will also be demolished.
