Membership on the committee varies from 12-15 members depending upon the application pool of a given year.

### *Eligibility*

All interested Cal students who plan to be enrolled in and present on campus for both the Fall 2017 and Spring 2018 semesters are eligible. Students who are passionate about the quality of student life and the student experience at UC Berkeley, engaged in the campus community, and interested in student services and development outside of the classroom setting are encouraged to apply. We are seeking a broad representation of Cal students. Applicants must be available to attend monthly meetings on Tuesdays (usually on the second week of the month) from 5:10-7:00 p.m.

- College you are enrolled in and the major(s) and minor(s), if applicable, you have declared
- Your e-mail address, phone number, and current address, including your primary contact information for the summer (or when you are away from campus).
